Please describe your company

Please describe the differences between IELTS and other tests

The IELTS is internationally recognized as an English academic assessment test for people who would like to enter a university in an English-speaking country or to immigrate to Canada, Australia and New Zealand. It is recognized by most universities around the world. The TOEFL IBT's main difference is that it does not have a live interview. Also no other test in the world is recognized by as many universities and government agencies than the IELTS.

How do students prepare for IELTS?

Students prepare for the IELTS through intensive academic reading, writing, listening and speaking training, which is very similar to the style and difficulty they would encounter in an English university setting.

What English level is necessary for studying in U.K.?

4.0 to enter a language school, usually 5.5 to enter foundation courses for university and between a 6.5-7.0 to

enter a degree course either undergraduate or postgraduate.

What steps are necessary in order to study in U.K.?

Students would have to meet the academic entry requirements then reach the appropriate IELTS level. They would have to apply (the process would take anywhere from 3-8 weeks) and apply for a visa.

What are some benefits of using SI-UK?

All of our counselors have lived and or studied in the U.K., most are British Council trained, SI-UK is visited regularly by U.K. universities to meet students and train staff, and all of our services are free.
